Kangaroos to Play Tonga in Historic Auckland Test Match By NRL

THE AUSTRALIAN Kangaroos will take on Mate Ma'a Tonga for the very first time in an end-of-season Test on Saturday October 20, 2018.

In a major boost for the growth of the international game, the historic match will take place at Mt Smart Stadium in Auckland the week following the New Zealand-Australia clash.

"This is a fantastic result for all fans of Rugby League and the continued growth of the international game," NRL CEO Todd Greenberg said.

"Many people have worked tirelessly right around the globe to ensure this match takes place.

"I'd particularly like to thank the NZRL for their efforts to ensure this match eventuated on New Zealand soil, along with the RLPA and the players.

"Tonga are the fourth-ranked team in the world and have fully earned their right to take on the World-Champion Kangaroos."

Kangaroos Coach Mal Meninga said the match would be an enormous boost for the international game.

"This will be a great occasion and it is something I know the players are excited about," Meninga said.

"This will be an important game not only for the Kangaroos but for the international game.

"As a game it's important to capitalise on the success of the World Cup last year, and particularly the success of Tonga and the other Pacific nations.

"Tonga's performances last year captured the imag-

ination of so many people in the game and I'm sure the game in Tonga will grow even more with games like this taking place."

Stuart Turner, Head of Major Events at Auckland Tourism, Events and Economic Development (AT-EED), added: "Mālō e lava mai. Auckland is delighted to have secured another history-making Rugby League event here in the world's largest Polynesian city, where our sizeable Tongan community is full of passionate and loyal league fans.

"Fans from Auckland, New Zealand and around the world packed Mt Smart Stadium for the Rugby League World Cup semi final last November, and it's exciting to think we could repeat a sell out again, over New Zealand's long Labour Weekend, less than 12 months on."

Members tickets will be on sale from \$20 for adults and \$50 for families, while General Public tickets will be on sale from \$25 for adults and \$65 for families.

Tickets will be on sale for Ticketed Members today (Wednesday, 5 September) at 10am AEST (12pm NZT), and for Non-Ticketed Members at 2pm AEST (4pm NZT).

CLUB'S FIRST WOMEN'S TEAM NAMED

A NEXPERIENCED all-international spine is a feature of the first Warriors side named to face the Sydney Roosters in the opening match of the inaugural NRL women's premiership at ANZ Stadium in Sydney on Saturday (3.05pm local time; 5.05pm NZT).

Coach Luisa Avaiki has named 2017 New Zealand Rugby League player of the year Apii Nicholls at fullback, captain Laura Mariu and Georgia Hale in the halves and Krystal Rota at hooker.

It's the same combination the Warriors started with in their 32-4 trial win over Auckland at Mount Smart Stadium on August 10.

Avaiki mixed up combinations for the second trial against Auckland on August 25, which the Warriors battled to win 20-16.

The Warriors women and the club's NRL side feature in a double header on Saturday with the Stephen Kearney-coached Vodafone Warriors taking on Penrith in a week one finals elimination contest at 5.30pm; it's the Vodafone Warriors first taste of NRL finals football since the 2011 grand final.

To add to the historic nature of the occasion, there'll be a special first when mother and son Lorina and Isaiah Papali'i represent the club in official matches for the first time and so do on the same day and the same ground. In another twist they will both be wearing the No 15 jersey and are both named on the interchange bench for their teams.

A feature of the women's kit is that each jersey is personalised with the player's name which they will wear throughout the competition.

The Warriors women go into the historic campaign buoyed by announcements yesterday that Flight Centre has signed as the front of jersey sponsor and Twenty8 Essentials on the shorts.
